Agriculture Technology Information Centre

In the year 1995-96, using infrastructure of the University, an independent Communication Centre was established. Subsequently, the Centre became one of the pioneer centres in India. Recognizing this, the Indian Council of Agricultural Research, New Delhi provided financial support for establishing full-fledged Agricultural Technology Information Centre (ATIC) in 1999. Thus, the advantage of the Single Window delivery system is being availed by more and more farmers of the Konkan region in particular and Maharashtra in general. ATIC provides an access to the visitors to the technology generated by the University, provides consultancy in agriculture, looks after publicity, publications and public relations at university level. ATIC has a separate sale counter wherein, the technology inputs of the University are made available to the visitors.
